Thank You for being a part of our Church Community yard Sale. We are pleased you are participating! We are looking forward to a day full fellowship, fun, and community. Whether you are selling, shopping, or browsing, we hope this event will be an opportunity to connect, share, and enjoy time together.

To help make this day enjoyable for everyone, please keep these guidelines in mind:

Before the Community Yard Sale:

- Sellers must register by September 16, 2026, which includes non-refundable payment.
- To Register: Call St. Paul's at 609-267-0740 with your Name, Email & Phone Number.
- Spaces are \$20 for a 10'x10' space (pavement or grass). Payment can be made through Venmo, Check, or Cash.
- Registration and Set-Up is between 7 AM – 8:30 AM on September 26, 2026. (Rain Date 10/3/26.)
- Sellers are responsible for bringing their own tables, chairs, tents, and display materials.
- All Sellers and their designee(s) are to adhere to all guidelines.

Set Up and Display:

- Sellers must keep all displays within the area that is assigned to them.
- Walkways and entrances should remain clear and accessible for all visitors.
- Tents, canopies, and displays must be secured to prevent injuries.

Sales and Payments:

- All Items are to be safe, family-friendly, and generally clean.
- Sellers and Shoppers must treat each other with kindness and respect
- Sellers are responsible for handling their own transactions and making their own change.
- Sellers are responsible for pricing. St. Paul's will not broker any transactions.
- All sales are final unless agreed upon by the seller and the buyer – No additional transactions on St. Paul's property.
- The following items are prohibited: tobacco and all other smoking products, alcohol, medications, firearms, adult-only items, and animals.
- Event organizers reserve the right to ask Sellers to remove items that are deemed unsafe or inappropriate.

Safety and Conduct:

- Sellers are expected to treat one another with courtesy and respect.
- Negotiations and interactions with Shoppers must remain courteous and respectful.
- Small children must remain under the supervision of a parent or guardian. The St. Paul's playground will be closed during all phases of the Community Yard Sale.
- Sellers and Participants will adhere to local ordinances and parking directions.

Clean-Up

- Sellers must remove all unsold items, trash, boxes, and displays at the end of the Community Yard Sale. Some receptacles will be available but no over spilling trash may be left.
- Sellers and Participants may not leave any items on the property for Event Organizers to discard.
- Sellers are expected to leave the space in the same condition they found it.

Liability

- St. Paul's is not responsible for lost, stolen, damaged or broken items.
- Sellers and participants assume all risks associated with participating in the Community Yard Sale.
